

Q2 How many employees are currently on your business's payroll? Please include all full-time, part-time, seasonal, and stand-by employees across all worksites within the state.










Q5 What are your current business challenges arising from? (select all that apply):


Q6 Has COVID-19 required you to furlough/layoff employees?


Q7 If you furloughed or laid-off employees, do you believe that within the next 3 months, you will:


Q8 Have the employees in your business taken a pay cut due to COVID-19?






Q11 What do you need to restart and bring employees back to work full-time? Check all that apply.


Q12 When you begin to restart or ramp up your business, what will be your biggest challenge in returning to more normal business operations? Check all that apply.




Q13 When you begin to restart or ramp up your business, what changes do you anticipate making or continuing for the next 6 to 12 months? Check all that apply.






Q15 Have you successfully attained federal aid or loans related to COVID-19?
